

## Punctuality and Attendance...





- The school day starts from 8.30am into class at 8.40am (precious support time reading, handwriting, home learning, mop up, pre teach!)
- Learning time is maximised 9.00am lesson begins (before if everyone present!)
- The Local Authority and Government expects the minimum satisfactory attendance to be at 95%
- If absent, inform school (phone or email school.admin NOT ClassDojo!) ASAP but by 9.00am (safeguarding procedures – 3 contacts)
- 100% termly and annual certificates

Having 90% attendance over a all of a child's time in school is the same as missing a complete year!

90% attendance is the same as having a day off every two weeks.

Being 15 minutes late for school is the equivalent of missing two weeks of school each year!
